## Limitations & problems with existing data collection

#### 1) Harmonization

 Establish common requirements across jurisdictions that enhance compliance & result in better protection of both environment and public.

#### 2) Enhance efficiency and effectiveness

 Establish clear and simple reporting thresholds that help reduce regulatory burden while at the same time strengthens protection.

### 3) Increase transparency and industry accountability

Leads to improved safety performance throughout industry and enables
Canadians to be better informed on industry's performance.

#### 4) Differentiate

 Separate performance reporting for the upstream (feeder and gathering pipelines) and midstream (transmission pipeline) sectors to more accurately represent industry's safety and environmental performance.
