


CATS Program Mission

To advance public safety, environmental protection, and pipeline reliability by facilitating clear communications among all pipeline stakeholders, including the public, pipeline operators, and government officials.

National CATS Coordinator Responsibilities

- Develops the National CATS Action Plan
 - Establish risk-based priorities for regionally based CATS
 - Communicate national program initiatives to CATS
- Provide support in hiring of new CATS Managers
- Create and deliver communications targeting community and governmental organizations (presentations, newsletters, etc.)
- Facilitate monthly CATS meetings
- Actively attend & present at stakeholder meetings & conferences
- Manage and support damage prevention initiatives:
- Public Awareness (workshop, program effectiveness planning)
- Grant program management
- Coordinate changes to Stakeholder Communication (Operator Pages) and SharePoint

CATS Manager Responsibilities

- Serve as a regional point-of-contact to facilitate communications regarding pipeline safety among:
 - PHMSA
 - Other federal agencies
 - State pipeline safety regulators
 - Elected and emergency officials
 - Pipeline operators
 - Public/landowners
- Respond to public inquiries and complaints regarding pipelines and pipeline operations
- Speak and present at pipeline safety meetings, conferences, workshops on a variety pipeline topics
- Participate with local and state officials in emergency-response drills
- Consult with OPS headquarters on rulemaking activities (e.g., the IM rule for gas pipelines, integration of RP 1162 into rule, etc.)
- Perform inspections (<u>Public Awareness</u>, Operator Qualification, Security, Operations and Maintenance, and Integrity Management inspections)
- Participate on Common Ground Alliance Committees
